

## **Rabindra Bhavan**

Rabindra Bhavan, the auditorium standing on Aghore Sarani, a very busy and important thoroughfare connecting Rajpur Phari to Sonarpur, is extremely popular amidst the local populace as is evident from its continuous usage.

Constructed in 1983-'84, it was the only auditorium of Rajpur Sonarpur and the Panchayats in its vicinity. Perhaps it was the largest in 24 Parganas (South) for a considerable period of time.

Having fallen in a state of disrepair and disorientation, it demanded prompt attention and so, the Rajpur-Sonarpur Municipality took advantage of this necessity of repairing and turned Rabindra Bhavan into a modern, centrally air-conditioned well equipped Auditorium, ensuring comfort of its audience and performers with the help of an aptly designed Proscenium Stage sporting post modern stage illumination system and Bose sound system, its Backstage comprising 4 nos. of Green Rooms for artistes and V.I.P.s, a Sitting area for 629 persons on Ground floor and Balcony ascertaining proper viewing and audibility and spacious Foyers with adequate Toilet and provision for purified drinking water. It caters to the differently abled as well.

Rabindra Bhavan has a Conference Hall for 85 persons with appropriate audio-visual system and an exclusive Meeting room for V.I.P.s

Electricity is ensured for 24 hours by its 400 KVA D.G. set whereas protection from fire by its Fire Fighting and alarm system. It is under CC TV surveillance.

Rabindra Bhavan can be booked for programmes and performances from the Harinavi office of Rajpur-Sonarpur Municipality on working days within office hours.
